Subject: Mobile DVR Phone Support

Purpose & Scope

This procedure can be used daily to make sure your Mobile Eye setup is working correctly. It can also be used to troubleshoot problems.

Procedure

With Car started and Mobile Eye booted up:

1. Sync Mic Pack with base by inserting Mic Pack into base and listen for beep.
2. Be sure the speaker is turned on. Switch is located on the back on the lower left of the speaker.
3. Remove Mic Pack from base and move slide switch to on. Alarm 1 should appear on the monitor and the Green LED should be on. Speak into mic pack should hear audio from the speaker, (speaker feedback is normal).
4. Slide Mic Pack switch to the off position. Leave the Mic Pack out of the base. Wait for DVR to stop recording.
5. Turn the light bar on. Alarm 2 should appear on the monitor and the Red Camera LED should be on. After a few seconds the mic pack should beep and you should hear audio from the speaker, (speaker feedback is normal).
6. Turn Light Bar off, wait for DVR to stop Recording.
7. Move Toggle Switch to Rear Mic Position. Front camera should be on monitor. Alarm 2 should appear on the monitor and the Red Camera LED should be on. After a few seconds the mic pack should beep and you should hear audio from the speaker, (speaker feedback is normal). Talk into rear mic, (cover mic pack with hand while talking). You won't hear rear mic audio from speaker you will hear it when you playback video.
8. Return toggle switch to center position. Wait for DVR to Stop Recording.
9. Move toggle switch to rear Camera/Rear Mic position. Rear camera should be on monitor. Alarm 2 should appear on the monitor and the Red Camera LED should be on. After a few seconds the mic pack should beep and you should hear audio from the speaker, (speaker feedback is normal). Talk into rear mic, (cover mic pack with hand while talking). You won't hear rear mic audio from speaker you will hear it when you playback video.
10. Return toggle switch to center position. Wait for DVR to Stop Recording.
11. Press EVENTS button on DVR and verify audio & video was recorded.
